2007 Christmas Challenge Cup Meet

Welcome to our annual Christmas Challenge Cup Meet.. Once again, clubs will be competing for the Senior and Junior Challenge Cups. The top six males and females in each age group in the 50m freestyle will be racing for cash in the Skins event– and the meet will finish with the Mystery Medley Relay for Junior and Senior teams.

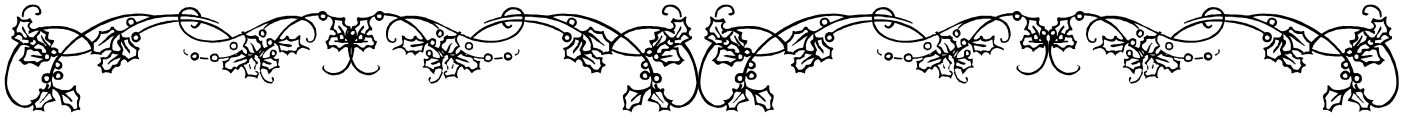
Meet Information

- ◆ The Junior Challenge Cup division will include 2 age groups
9 years & under, 10 – 11 years
- ◆ The Senior Challenge Cup division will include 3 age groups
12 – 13 years, 14 – 15 years, 16 years & over
- ◆ Each division will be scored separately
- ◆ Points will be awarded on a 14 – 10 – 8 – 6 – 4 – 2 basis in each age group/gender for each individual event.
- ◆ Only individual events will be scored
- ◆ There is no limit to team size
- ◆ Heats will be seeded on entry times
- ◆ Entries with no times will be swum in the slowest heat(s)
- ◆ There is a **maximum of 8** individual entries per swimmer.
- ◆ Swimmers may only enter **one 200m** event in the afternoon session.
- ◆ Age is as at Saturday 1 December 2007.
- ◆ Swimmers in individual events may swim up an age group but must swim in one age group only.
- ◆ All events will be swum as mixed timed finals
- ◆ Over the top starts will be used.
- ◆ Events will be swum under Swimming New Zealand Rules.
- ◆ All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules.
- ◆ Pool length is 25m.
- ◆ All relay teams should be club relays.

4x25m Skins Event

- ◆ The top six females and males in each of the five age groups from the 50m freestyle event will be invited to participate in the skins events. All six swimmers race in the first heat and the slowest two drop out. Then the four remaining swimmers swim 25m and the slowest drops out. This is repeated twice more to find the winner of each age group. Each leg of the Skins Challenge will start at 2 minute intervals whether swimmers are on the blocks or not. Skins events do not carry agegroup points.
- ◆ Cash prize for the female and male winner of each age group





Mystery Medley Relay

- ◆ Each team randomly draws the order of their events at the end of the morning session - and keep it to themselves as to the actual order (keeping it a mystery to the other teams). Because everyone is doing different strokes at the same time, it is hard to see who the winner will be till the very end...

Spot prize draws for competitors, officials and spectators.

Warm-Up and Start Time

- ◆ Warm up will be from 9.00am to 9.55am and will be divided into two 25minute sessions. Clubs will be notified of their allotted time.
- ◆ **Start time** 10.00am.

- ◆ There will be a one hour break between sessions 1 and 2. A barbecue will be operating during the lunch break.
